To protect San Carlos Apache tribal members and to limit the spread of COVID-19 the San Carlos Apache Tribal Council has declared a state of emergency on the San Carlos Apache Reservation. *see* Resolution Nos. MR-20-032, MR-20-033, MR-20-038 and MR-20-039. As part of the Tribal response to this emergency the Tribe has declared that any person ordered to self-quarantine by the San Carlos Apache Healthcare Corporation (SCAHC) or the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) must do so. The Tribe has further declared that if any person is directed to take a test for COVID-19, that person must do so immediately. Finally, the Tribe has ordered all persons to comply with any directive from a healthcare worker related to preventing the spread of COVID-19.

The health and wellness of everyone on the San Carlos Apache Reservation is SCAHC's main priority and SCAHC will make every effort to help limit the spread of COVID-19. This will not only include directing individuals to self-quarantine or take tests for COVID-19 if necessary, but also limiting access to certain areas of the Hospital and shutting down certain clinics or other services until they can be safely resumed.

Please follow all directives or orders issued by SCAHC or DHHS healthcare workers. If you fail to follow these directives or orders you may be charged with obstructing Tribal operations. We must work together to fight COVID-19 by remaining calm and cooperative.
