- Cultural sensitivity or membership in a federally recognized Indian Tribe
- Substantial profit or non-profit financial management experience
- Management experience in the field of healthcare or business with no less than a Master's Degree
- A degree in medicine from a nationally accredited medical school
- A registered nurse who has graduated from a nursing program at a college or university, who has passed a national licensing exam, and who has obtained a nursing license

San Carlos Apache Healthcare Board Member Vacancy

The San Carlos Apache Health Care Corporation, Inc. (SCAHC) is a 501(c)(3), nonprofit Corporation chartered by the Tribal Council of the San Carlos Apache Tribe.

SCAHC is a Tribal 638 tribally owned enterprise of the Tribe for the advancement of the health and social welfare of the Tribe and its members, and to assist the Tribe in achieving greater self-sufficiency and self-government and in stimulating employment, entrepreneurial, and economic opportunities within the San Carlos Apache Reservation

The Corporation shall at all times be guided by the Apache Way and the value system it embodies. Central to the Apache Way is the concept of Gozhoo, which is a state of goodness, balance, harmony, and beauty leading to personal and societal well-being. In the context of the Corporation, or Izeé Baa Gowah, adherence to the Apache Way means that the Corporation shall strive to heal, serve and empower the Ndee (Apache people) while honoring Apache traditions through a compassionate and respectful patient and family centered team, as permitted by the patient.

The Corporation shall aspire to bring Gozhoo to the Apache people by fostering goodness, balance, harmony and beauty through our actions; delivering high-quality, holistic health care for the benefit of present and future generations; and ultimately creating a strong, healthy community where Apaches heal Apaches. Doing so will require embracing the spiritual and physical value of healing by living in harmonious and peaceful environment through Gozhoo; acting with competence and accountability and protecting patient confidentiality; building trust in all of the Corporation's relationships, and recognizing the power of Apache history to produce resiliency, self-reliance, and self-determination.

Applicants must meet the following requirements according to the SCAHC Bylaws:

Members. The Board shall include no fewer than five (5) and no more than seven (7) voting member directors ("Director"). Each Director shall be entitled to one vote at Board meetings. All subsequent appointments shall be recommended by the Board to the Chairperson of the Tribal Council, subject to the qualifications set forth in Section 2.9 below, who shall submit the Board's recommendation to the Tribal Council. Board members may only be approved and appointed by a majority of the Tribal Council voting in a Tribal Council meeting in the form of a resolution.

Qualifications. Qualifications for Board Members should include, but not be limited to, the following:

- A. Past employment with a Hospital, Clinic or Healthcare Management Organization in a management capacity with recognized accomplishments; or
- B. Cultural sensitivity or membership in a federally recognized Indian Tribe;
- C. Substantial profit or non-profit financial management experience;
- D. Management experience in the field of healthcare or business with no less than a Master Degree;
- E. A degree in medicine from a nationally accredited medical school; or
- F. A registered nurse who has graduated from a nursing program at a college or university, who has passed a national licensing exam, and who has obtained a nursing license.

Composition. Directors, excluding Honorary Directors, shall be members of the Tribe with preference given to residents of one of the communities of San Carlos Apache Tribe's service delivery area as defined by Section 1.3.2 of the Self-Determination Agreement between the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services and the San Carlos Apache Tribe's ("Contract"). Contract No. HHSI24701520001C or any successor agreement.
